## Team Premier (UAE20) wins second Grade 1 event in a row. Transbunker Sailing Team (UAE7) in second place.

After the 20<sup>th</sup> *H.M.King Juan Carlos I Trophy* in Cascais last month, the *Grand Prix Guyader*, in Douarnenez, is the 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade 1 event in the European circuit and was once again won by *Team Premier* (Hendrik Witzmann, Markus Koy & Henrique Anjos).

Racing conditions were very difficult in Douarnenez. Very light winds and heavy rain on the first day of racing. Followed by 2 days of over 30 knots and no races. On Thursday 3 difficult races were sailed in light, shifty and unpredictable conditions. *Team Premier* made the best out of the conditions achieving a 4th, 6th and 10th place. Overall, after 4 races, *Team Premier* was leading with more than 20 points (no discard). Witzman: "Sailing in these shifty conditions was very similar to sailing on my home lake".

The *Transbunker Sailing Team* (UAE7, Markus Wieser, George Leonchuk and Sergei Pugachev) finished overall second, equal on points as the third Lars Hendriksen and team (DEN138).

Wieser: "Team Premier is on a roll, they keep getting better and better. Our winter training in Dubai helped them improve alot I look forward to the Worlds in La Rochelle next month".
